Approval of Agenda:

Dawn Holdgate moved to approve the agenda. The motion was duly seconded by Joseph Topham, and the motion carried UNANIMOUSLY.

Milestone and Polpis Path and Intersection Improvements

Patrick Reed, Transportation Program Manager provided the Commission with an update and requested that the Commission endorse a letter of support that:

- 1) Acknowledge MassDOT's desire to improve the intersection of Milestone and Polpis prior to permitting the Town's proposed path
- 2) Requests MassDOT take over oversight, design, and construction of the path and intersection projects
- 3) Acknowledge further coordination on long-term solutions

Mr. Reed also provided the Commission with a background timeline of the proposed improvements. The improvements would provide continuous safe access on the North side of Milestone Road from the rotary to the Polpis path and would also include intersection improvements at the intersection of Milestone Road and Polpis Road.
