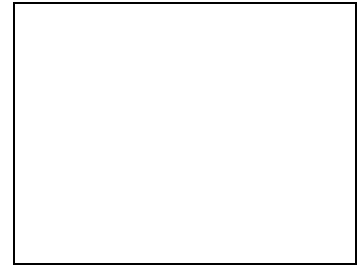




Nantucket Cultural Council Minutes
