Status of Roads and Right of Way Committee

The committee and Tracy discussed the future of the Roads and Right of Way Committee. Tracy mentioned a need to help the Town address the growing encroachment issues. Tracy mentioned that the members of Roads and Right of Way would be welcomed onto other committees, or the committee could continue as it has been and look to expand its role. Phil Smith said that the committee will be receiving a draft of the harbor plan, and Roads and Right of Ways is listed in a number of recommendations in the plan. Phil Smith said that the committee should certainly finish that project before considering dissolving. Ed Gillum also said that the committee plays a great role in receiving feedback from members of the island community. Bill Grieder suggested a liaison position be created between Roads and Right of Way and the Traffic Safety committee to help add yellow lines in front of houses as the town attempts to enforce the encroachment policy.

Other Business and Member Comments

The committee discussed what would be on the agenda for the next meeting. The committee agreed that they should discuss encroachments and elections for new leaders. They decide to have the meeting in a hybrid form.

The committee discussed public outreach regarding encroachments and the role of general education in solving this problem.
