

ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF NONVOTING TAXPAYERS

Minutes of Public meeting 10:00 am, Saturday, August 15, 2026

1. Attending members: Kathy Baird, Gene Briskman, Jon Delano, Patti Deuster, Bill Gardner, Peter Halle, Mike Herlihy, Peter Kahn, Eric Krauetler, Donna Martino, Steve Perelman, Scott Ulm, Bob Vidoni. Members absent: Lou Bassano, Pamela Suan
2. Chair Peter Halle convened the meeting at 10:00 am and read the Virtual Meeting Script, confirming a quorum was present.
3. The Agenda for today's meeting was moved for approval, seconded and passed unanimously.
4. Approval of the minutes as corrected from the August 1, 2026 meeting was moved, seconded and passed unanimously.
5. Peter H. introduced our Guest Speaker, Mike Burns, Transportation Program Manager who used a slide deck [Transportation Program Manager Update ACNVT August 15, 2026](#) to inform attendees. Mr. Burns presented data for vehicle carrying capacity, public transportation (WAVE ridership), traffic modeling, a home build out analysis, bike path status, sidewalk obstruction information and elaborated on a list of on-going projects. Mr. Burns invited members to participate in the Transportation Public Access Advisory Committee (TPAC). Mr. Burns then answered questions from members and other attendees.
6. Brooke Mohr (Select Board), guest attendee, shared her views on the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) prioritization process and transportation issues, encouraging members to 'take the bus' or ride a bike whenever possible. Ms. Mohr suggested downloading the [Click and Fix Nantucket](#) mobile application where road issues and their location could be quickly communicated to the Department of Public Works (DPW). Ms. Mohr also encouraged members to subscribe to the [Town Manager's Newsletter](#) for an overview of what is happening in town government (including links to detailed information for specific interests) and to track local social media as town outreach efforts continue to increase.
7. Carole Beller shared Brant Point neighborhood specific concerns about illegal parking and requested a parking study for the neighborhood.
8. On behalf of Jon, Steve provided an update of the ACNVT Communications Committee work with Town Administration, finalizing the town newsletter input and website update for ACNVT, setting up an ACNVT town email

address, increasing outreach through local media and neighborhood organizations, and fostering active town committee participation/expertise.

9. Peter H. noted that there had been no Coastal Resiliency Advisory Committee (CRAC) meeting ACNVT's last meeting but provided an update on the [in-person CRAC Project workshops](#) that had been held around the island 8/12-13.
10. Our last in-person/hybrid meeting scheduled for August 29 at 10AM at Safety Center Training Room with guest speaker DPW Director Drew Patenode. Future meetings are not yet scheduled but potential speakers include Municipal Housing Director Kristie Ferrantella, Select Board member Bob DeCosta, and after they have settled in to their new roles in the future, the Director of Finance and Health Director.
11. Public Comment – Bruce Mandel shared his process for outreach to nonvoting taxpayers in the Madaket neighborhoods that included surveys with QR codes using a list of voluntarily submitted property owner emails.
12. New Business - none
13. Motion to adjourn was seconded and passed unanimously at 12:11pm.
